Christ's Part: The Story Behind the Anthem

In 2000, I was the choir director at a United Methodist Church in Pennsylvania. The evening of the

religious background, Mom and Dad and Pat and Betty Lou hit it off immediately. And so, over the next

8 years or so, it became a tradition that when Mom and Dad would visit Debbie and I over the Christmas

and New Year's holidays, we would invite Pat and Betty Lou over for a holiday dinner of standing rib

roast – *always* standing rib roast!

Mom passed on November 9, 2014. That morning, while Debbie and I were on the way to be with my

Dad, we received the call that Pat had passed – on the same day, only a few hours before Mom. I still

have this picture in my heart, of Pat meeting Mom, the two of them entering heaven together to join and

introduce each other to their waiting heavenly relatives and friends.
